## GUIDELINES TO CANDIDATES

### M. Pharmacy/ Pharm. D (P.B.) Courses

The candidates are hereby informed that the leftover vacancies in Private Unaided Non-Minority and Minority colleges will be filled by the Institutional Spot Admissions to be held at the respective colleges. **The candidates desirous of seeking admission are informed to contact the Principals of the respective institutions.**

- Candidates without original certificates are not permitted for spot admissions.
- Candidate shall be present in person at the college with all original certificates for spot admissions. The candidate has to handover original certificates and 2 sets of Xerox copies of certificates at the college. After due ratification, the original certificates shall be returned to the candidate Except Original Transfer Certificate.
- **Fee reimbursement is not applicable to the candidates admitted under Institutional Spot Admissions.**

#### I. Eligibility Criteria for M. Pharmacy/ Pharm. D (P.B.) Courses:

1. The candidate should be of Indian Nationality.
2. The candidate should belong to Telangana.
3. The candidates should satisfy the local / unreserved status requirements as specified in G.O.Ms.No. 15 Higher Education (TE) Department dated 27-02-2025. Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in each course in the Educational Institutions in the State for the local candidates of O.U. Area as specified in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended and  
**the remaining 15% of the seats shall be unreserved Seats as follows:**
  - (i) All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of O.U. Area.
  - (ii) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the State;
  - (iii) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi Public Institution within the State; and
  - (iv) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and educational Institutions recognized by the Government or a University or Other competent authority and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State.
4. Candidate should have passed the qualifying examination and secured not less than 55% (50% in case of reserved categories) for **M. Pharmacy and Pharm-D (P.B.)**.

- i. TG PGCET-2025 Rank Card.
- ii. SSC Marks Memo Original.
- iii. Intermediate or its equivalent Marks Memo Original.
- iv. Original Degree / Provisional Certificate (PC) & Consolidate Memorandum of Marks (CMM) of the qualifying examination.
- v. Study Certificates Originals.
- vi. Transfer Certificate.
- vii. Caste Certificate, if applicable.
- viii. Residence Certificate, if applicable.

**III. PROCESSING FEE DETAILS:**

The candidates have to pay the following Processing Fee at the college Rs.600/- for SC/ST candidates and Rs.1200/-for others at the time of joining and an amount of Rs 100/- have to pay under the head "Telangana Green Fund"
