DETAILED NOTIFICATION FOR SECOND AND FINAL PHASE OF WEB COUNSELLING
(M. Pharmacy/ Pharm. D (P.B.))

The GPAT qualified and eligible candidates of 2024, 2025 and 2026, and TG PGECET-2026 qualified and eligible candidates who have not registered for the Phase-I counselling are informed to attend Phase-II (Final Phase) online TG PGEC / TG PGECET Web Based Counseling for admission to **M. Pharmacy/ Pharm. D (P.B.)** programs for the academic year 2026-2027 as per the schedule given below:

- Candidates are hereby informed that they should satisfy the admission rules prescribed in the related G.O. MS. No.153 besides satisfying the eligibility criteria of the respective universities and should be prepared to pay the tuition fee as applicable.
- The leftover seats after allotment for GPAT candidates are only available for TG PGECET candidates.
- This notification itself is a call for web counseling. No separate call letters are sent to the individual candidates.
- Mere attending of the web counseling does not guarantee a seat in any college.
- All the candidates are required to register online at <http://pgcetadm.tgche.ac.in> on scheduled dates and furnish all information in the application form. **All the entries should be correct, and the candidates are solely responsible for any incorrect entry.**
- All the candidates required to pay a non-refundable processing fee Rs. 1200 (Rupees: Twelve Hundred only) towards **Registration cum Verification** process. For SC/ST Candidates, the fee is Rs. 600 (Rupees: Six Hundred only) the fee must be paid online through Credit Cards/Debit Cards/Internet Banking in favour of '**The Secretary, TGCHE**'.
- In respect of reimbursement of Tuition Fee will be as per guidelines issued vide G.O.Ms.No. 08 and 09 dated 06-06-2026 Scheduled Castes Development (EDN.A1) Department and further guidelines issued by Government from time to time.

- Telangana Haritha Nidhi: As per G.O. Ms No 17; dated 18th February, 2022 an amount of Rs 100/- will be collected under the head “Telangana Green Fund” from students who secured seats in Professional Courses along with the tuition fee.
- The Candidate once allotted seat shall note that if they exercise options in Second phase and a seat is allotted as per the options, the vacated seat will be allotted to next meritorious candidate and hence they will have no claim on previous allotment.
- If the candidate does not pay the prescribed Tuition Fee within the schedule mentioned, the provisional allotted seat automatically stands cancelled and he / she shall not have any claim on the provisionally allotted seat.
- Physical reporting of the candidate at the allotted college is mandatory in every phase.
- It is mandatory to exercise options afresh for Each phase. First phase options will not be considered for Second phase.
- Dropouts/Cancellations are not permitted after Second Phase Allotments.

Who should participate in Phase-II?

1. Who secured a seat in phase-I of web-based counselling and wish to move to some other college?
2. Candidates who participated in phase I of web-based counselling and could not secure a seat.
3. Candidates who did not participate in phase I even though he / she has been called for counselling.
4. Candidates who were allotted a seat but didn't report.
5. A candidate allotted a seat in phase I but cancelled his / her admission.

The candidates may note that,

1. **Options exercised for first phase will not be considered for second phase of counselling.**
2. Candidates have to exercise options fresh option for each phase of web-based counselling.
3. In case, if they are satisfied with the previous allotment, options need not be exercised again.
4. Options may be exercised for those colleges even if the vacancies are not available, as vacancies may arise due to sliding, cancellation and conversions.

 If the candidate secures a seat in Phase – II, he / she will lose the claim on the earlier allotted college and has to report to the new college by downloading the allotment letter on or before the date furnished in the allotment letter. Failing to report within the date furnished in the allotted college, the candidate will forfeit the claim on the new college as well as in the old college.

b. Eligibility:

1. The candidate should be of Indian Nationality.
2. The candidate should belong to the State of Telangana.
3. The candidate should satisfy the local/Unreserved status requirements as laid down in the regulations of admission. (Ref. G.O.Ms.No.153 dated 22-08-2007 and G.O.Ms.No. 15 Higher Education (TE) Department dated 27-02-2026)
4. Candidate should have passed the qualifying examination and secured not less than 55% (50% in case of reserved categories) for **M. Pharmacy and Pharm-D (P.B.)**.

c. Certificates to be uploaded at the time of Registration and filling application form

The GPAT / TG PGECET qualified, eligible candidates have to scan and upload all original certificates for verification. The candidates shall upload scanned copies of the following Original Certificates for verification.

1. GPAT Score card /PGECET Rank Card.
2. Original Degree / Provisional Certificate (PC) & Consolidate Memorandum Marks (CMM) of qualifying Examination.
3. Intermediate/Diploma/10+2 Certificate.
4. SSC pass certificate or its Equivalent for proof of Date of Birth.
5. Bonafide (Study) certificates from Class IX to Graduation.
6. Residence certificate for preceding 7 years of the qualifying examination i.e. Graduation in respect of candidates who have private study without any institutionalized education (Distance / Open education mode).
7. Latest Integrated community (Caste) certificate issued by the competent authority in case of BC/SC/ST candidates issued after 02.06.2014, if applicable.
8. Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) Reservation (applicable only to OC candidates) Candidates should produce EWS Certificate issued by MRO/ Tahsildar valid for the year 2026-27, if applicable.
9. Transfer Certificate (TC)
10. Latest Income Certificate on or after 01.01.2026, if applicable.
11. In respect of non-local candidates in order to consider them for allotment under unreserved seats the following certificates need to be submitted:
 Residence Certificate: Candidates who has resided in the State of Telangana for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of study outside the State; or either of whose parents have resided in the State of Telangana for a total period of 10 years excluding periods of employment outside the State.
 (OR)
 Employer Certificate: Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of the State of Telangana or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local bodies, Universities and other similar Quasi Public Institutions within the State of Telangana at the time of applying for GPAT/TG PGECET- 2026 examination.
 (OR)
 Candidate who are spouses of those in the employment in the State of Telangana or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local bodies, Universities and Educational Institutions recognized by the Govt. or University or Other Competent authority and similar Quasi Govt. Institutions within the State of Telangana at the time of applying for GATE/GPAT/TG PGECET- 2026) examination.
12. The Muslim and Christian Minority Candidates should upload the “TC” of the SSC containing Minority status (or) in the absence of TC, a Certificate mentioning minority status issued by the Head of the Institution in which the student studied/appeared for SSC or its equivalent examination.

Note:- *Any false or incorrect information furnished in the online application form and subsequently detected at any stage of the admissions process will render the admission of the candidate null and void.

* The Convener reserves the right to cancel the admission of the candidates at any stage if / when it is detected that admission is against the rules.

Certificate verification and counseling:

1. The preliminary certificate verification will be done based on scanned copies of original documents uploaded and as per norms.
2. In case of any doubt, enquiry will be done over phone to establish the veracity and correctness of documents. Hence, candidates are required to respond to the phone calls from the verification officer.

3. Procedure for exercising options will be made available on the website i.e. <http://pgecetadm.tgche.ac.in> well before the commencement of the option entry.
4. List of Provisionally selected candidates will be prepared College wise and will be placed on the website i.e. <http://pgecetadm.tgche.ac.in> and SMS will be sent to the valid mobile number furnished in the online application.
5. The candidates have to pay tuition fee through online mode (**credit card/debit card/internet banking**).
6. Final allotment of seat for admission is subject to satisfactory verification of all original certificates at reported college and producing of fee paid receipt.
7. Candidates must report to the concerned college and produce all original certificates within the stipulated time.
8. Allotment order will be printed at the college as also joining report, which has to be submitted at the college along with original T.C.
9. Candidates must submit two sets of self attested copies of all certificates at the respective colleges, one set is meant for submission to the office of the Convener.
10. If the candidate cancels his/her admission tuition fee will be forfeited as mentioned below:
 - After first phase, full tuition fee will be refunded.
 - 50% of the amount after final phase and before cutoff date notified for cancellation in allotment order and 100% thereafter.

Rules of Reservation for admission.

Admissions will be made as per rules of reservations in vogue at the time of Counseling.

1. The candidates should satisfy the local / unreserved status requirements as specified in G.O.P. No. 646 dated 10th July, 1979 and its amendments and G.O.Ms.No. 15 Higher Education (TE) Department dated 27-02-2025

Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in each course in the Educational Institutions in the State for the **local candidates of O.U. Area** as specified in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended and

the remaining 15% of the seats shall be unreserved seats, as follows:

- a. All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of O.U. Area.
 - b. Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the State;
 - c. Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi Public Institution within the State; and
 - d. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies Universities and educational Institutions recognized by the Government or a University or Other competent authority and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State.
2. Cent-percent (100%) of seats in University College and 70% of the sanctioned intake of seats in unaided (affiliated), non-minority and minority professional institutions will be filled by the Convener TG PGECET-2026 Admissions.

3. Reservation for various categories:

- a. Categories (as per G.O.RI.No.:550 dated 30.07.2001, G.O.Ms.No.33 dated 08-02-2021 and G.O.Ms.No 10 Scheduled Cates Development (POA.A2) Department dated 14-04-2026)
